 - Strong Beginnings Preschool contract renewal for three-year-old children for funding as follows: \$168,000 per classroom (14 students/classroom; \$12,000/child; plus, transportation, as needed, at minimum rate of \$400/child (the allocation for transportation will be calculated by a formula after an analysis of transportation funds needed by every ISD awarded Strong Beginnings funds). Wayne RESA: 4 classrooms for \$672,000, plus transportation; Northwest Educational Services: 3 classrooms for \$504,000, plus transportation; Heritage Southwest ISD: 3 classrooms for \$504,000, plus transportation; Berrien RESA - 2 classrooms for \$336,000, plus transportation.
